### **ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES:**

The Scientific Committee of the 1st International Conference on Migration and Gender Issues (2021 COMAGI) invites you to submit the 500-words abstract for the peer-reviewed e-collection of abstracts with ISBN that will be published at Alfred Nobel University, Dnipro City, Ukraine. The Scientific Committee will judge these abstracts, and only selected abstracts will be published. Copy of the e-collection will be provided to all authors at the conference.

- Abstracts must be written in British English, typed using Times New Roman (normal style and font size 12), and in MS-Word. Page size should be A4, single column with 2.0 cm margin on both sides with single line spacing.
- The body of abstracts should be divided into 4 sections: background, methods, results, and conclusions. Abstracts should include the title, name & surname of authors, affiliation, country, e-mail, phone number, SSIRN membership I.D., and keywords.
